CAAP/**alphaland** HANGAR MAP



The Alphaland Hangar is located at the nexus of Tramo Rd. (a.k.a. Aurora Boulevard), Airport Rd. and Andrews Ave. Depending on which direction you are coming from, the hangar is found right beside or before the traffic light. There is no sign on the building, but it has two distinctive red bar gates. For security reasons, extended and overnight parking is strictly NOT permitted. Alphaland shall not be liable for any loss or damages which may occur while vehicles are parked in the area.

From NAIA/Paranaque

- Take Domestic Road past the Domestic Terminal. Turn right to Andrews Avenue at the rotonda, staying in the rightmost lane. When you see a wall to your right with a Dutch Boy paint advertisement, slow down. The entrance to the hangar is a gate made of red (not orange) bars shortly after.

From Laguna/Alabang/Sucat/SLEX/Newport City

- From SLEX, exit to NAIA/ Newport. At Newport, the road curves right, and becomes Andrews Avenue going to Tramo. Go around the Terminal 3 round-about and continue towards the Domestic Airport.
- When you cross Aurora Boulevard (Tramo Rd.) on your right, the hangar will be on your left shortly after, but you will have to go around.
- Take a left around the rotonda to Domestic Road. Go all the way to the entrance of the old Domestic Terminal, where there is a break in the traffic separators. Make a U-turn there and go back the way you came. Stay in the rightmost lane, which turns back towards Andrews Avenue. When you see a wall to your right with a Dutch Boy paint advertisement, slow down. The entrance to the hangar is a gate made of red (not orange) bars shortly after.

The Alphaland Hangar is located at the nexus of Tramo Rd. (a.k.a. From EDSA Southbound (Quezon City, Pasig, Makati)

- Go up the Magallanes Cloverleaf, left side, towards Pasay. Stay on the leftmost lane, and take the Tramo (a.k.a. Aurora Boulevard) flyover. Continue along Tramo, staying in the right lane, until it ends at Airport Road/Andrews Avenue. The hangar is actually almost straight ahead, but to get to it, you will have to go around.
- Turn right to Airport Road, then swing left around the rotonda, to Domestic Road. Go all the way to the entrance of the old Domestic Terminal, where there is a break in the traffic separators. Make a U-turn there and go back the way you came. Stay in the rightmost lane, which turns back towards Andrews Avenue. When you see a wall to your right with a Dutch Boy paint advertisement, slow down. The entrance to the hangar is a gate made of red (not orange) bars shortly after.

From EDSA Northbound (Roxas Boulevard, Pasay, Manila)

- Cross Taft Avenue and turn right at Tramo, then follow instructions above starting from Tramo.
